Driving Directions

Via the Washington Capital Beltway

Take Interstate 270 North (Exit 35) toward Frederick. Then take Exit 6B to merge onto MD-28/West Montgomery Avenue toward Darnestown. Turn right onto Research Boulevard. Make a left into the ASHA National Office at 2200 Research Boulevard.

From Rockville Metro Station

Take the [Metro Red Line](#) to Rockville Metro Station. From there, take [Ride On Bus 54](#) towards Lakeforest Mall (Monday-Sunday) or take [Ride On Bus 63](#) towards Shady Grove Station (Monday- Friday).

From Shady Grove Metro Station

Take the [Metro Red Line](#) to Shady Grove Metro Station. From there, take [Ride On Bus 63](#) towards Rockville Station (Monday-Friday) or take [Ride On Bus 66](#) towards Trville Transit (Monday-Friday Rush Hours Only).

There is a Ride On bus stop directly in front of the National Office on both sides of Research Boulevard.
